Administrative History:

The Australian Garden History Society (AGHS) was formed at a conference in Melbourne in 1980.

The Society was formed to promote interest and research into historic gardens. It was also concerned, through a study of garden history, with the promotion of proper standards of design and maintenance that are relevant to the needs of today, and with the conservation of valuable plants that are in danger of being lost.

The Southern Highlands Branch of the AGHS was called the Southern NSW Branch of the AGHS until October 1989. Both names were used interchangeably for several years after that.
